	1. Starter & 5 Mi of free reading.	inute Reading: Each class this semester will start with 5 minutes	8	
	2. Introduce Lesson Concept: (1) Start with a question. {Why do people play games?}(2) Briefly talk about why people play games, and how a nation's culture can be reflected in the games that are played.			
#1	 Country Names: We will be focusing on about ten games from ten different countries, so the first activity will be to make sure that the students know the country names/locations. Briefly review the continent names. Give each table a large laminated world map. Show the country name on the PPT and have the students try to find it on the world map. (Confirm correct answers) 			
	4. Games Intro (Activity): Introduce the game/sport on the PPT. Students will play a game to guess which country each game/sport is from.			

	5.	Vote: Students will be told that they can choose one game to play next week. The whole class will vote on which game they want to play.	5
	1.	Starter & 5 Minute Reading: Each class this semester will start with 5 minutes of free reading.	8
	2.	Introduce Selected Game: Students will learn all about their selected game, and a bit about the country where this game is popular.	5
#2	3.	Play Selected Game: The whole class will play the game together.	15
	4.	Game Reflection: Students will write down some reflections that they have about the game. (Give them a worksheet with prompts & suggestions.)	12
	1.	Starter & 5 Minute Reading: Each class this semester will start with 5 minutes of free reading.	8
	2.	Warm up: Show the pictures of(彈珠、陀螺、毽子、扯鈴、跳房子、紙上尋寶) to guess the name of each game.	5
#3	3.	Introduce games we play in Taiwan (彈珠、陀螺、毽子、扯鈴、跳房子、紙上尋寶、踩高蹺): (1) Answer questions: Why do we have so many Taiwanese traditional folk games? Do you know the stories about these folk games? (2) Briefly talk about how a nation's culture can be reflected in the games that are played. (3) Show the video and pictures about how to play these folk games	17
	4.	Play games: The whole class will play the game together.	10
	5.	Assignment: Ask students to find out the information of modern game they played. Next class, they will introduce the modern games.
